

NEARSHORE STRATEGY SPECIES WITH OBSERVED OR PROBABLE OCCURRENCE WITHIN THE CAPE FOULWEATHER MARINE CONSERVATION AREA

NEARSHORE STRATEGY SPECIES are species determined to have conservation needs in greatest need of management attention and to have the greatest potential for benefit from management actions. Strategy Species provide a focus for planning and prioritizing specific conservation, management, and research actions by ODFW and other partners.

NEARSHORE WATCH LIST SPECIES are those that have been identified as important nearshore species but do not require immediate management action, but may in the future. Managers should be aware of conservation needs and potential factors affecting these species and that sufficient data for these species may be lacking.

NEARSHORE COMMONLY ASSOCIATED SPECIES are species identified to be important to nearshore environments, whose conservation needs can best be met through management affecting habitats or communities of organisms.

Cape Foulweather is home to the following species identified by the Oregon Conservation Strategy for the Nearshores Ecoregion. Included are listing status, special needs, and the State's recommended Conservation Actions particularly relevant to Rocky Habitats :

Bull kelp *Nereocystis luetkeana*

- Occurs only in nearshore subtidal habitat. This species is strongly associated with rocky substrates.
- Observe harvest restrictions. Monitor status of beds at special sites/index sites.

Cabezon *Scorpaenichthys marmoratus*

- Needs rocky reefs
- Protect critical habitat. Manage for sustainable harvest. Gather information to fill data gaps on declining population.

- Needs rocky reefs
- Protect critical habitat. Manage for sustainable harvest. Gather information to fill data gaps on juveniles in nearshore.

Ochre sea star *Pisaster ochraceus*

- Occur only in rocky intertidal and shallow subtidal habitat in nearshore and estuarine waters.

Sunflower star *Pycnopodia helanthoides*

NEARSHORE STRATEGY SPECIES WITH OBSERVED OR PROBABLE OCCURRENCE WITHIN THE CAPE FOULWEATHER MARINE CONSERVATION AREA

- Occur in lower intertidal and subtidal habitat. They are voracious predators, feeding on clams, snails, chitons, urchins, sand dollars, asteroids, crabs, and other invertebrates.
- Monitor status of populations at index sites. Gather information to fill data gaps to determine ecological role in subtidal communities and gather information on recruitment events.

Purple sea urchin *Strongylocentrotus purpuratus*

- Monitor status of populations at index sites. Gather information to fill data gaps on population dynamics (recruitment in relation to headlands). Manage for sustainable harvest

California mussel *Mytilus californianus*

- Occur only in rocky intertidal and shallow subtidal habitat.
- Investigate relationships between ocean drivers, larva supply, and episodic settlement/recruitment.

Pacific harbor seal *Phoca vitulina*

- Use haul-out sites on rocks, reefs, or beaches. They require pupping areas with minimal disturbance.
- Limit human disturbance. Observe federal Marine Mammal Protection Act protections. Fill data gaps on population status and trends.

NEARSHORE WATCH LIST SPECIES

- Cassin's Auklet (*Ptychoramphus aleuticus*): Nests in burrows on offshore islands with no mammalian predators.
- Rhinoceros Auklet (*Cerohinca monocerata*): Nests in burrows on offshore islands. Forages in nearshore waters while nesting.
- Brandt's Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax penicillatus*): Utilizes rocky cliffs and islands for nesting. Forages in nearshore habitats.
- Pelagic Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax pelagicus*): Utilizes rocky cliffs and islands for nesting. Forages in nearshore habitats.
- Pigeon Guillemot (*Cepphus columba*): Nests in burrows or crevices. Forages in nearshore habitats.
- Common Murre (*Uria aalge*) Central place forager while nesting in colonies on rocky headlands and offshore islands. Can dive deeply while foraging.
- Sanderling (*Calidris alba*): Forages in intertidal areas during migration.
